CBFM 1311 Building Maintenance I 3 Credit Hours (2 Lec, 3 Lab)

Basic principles of residential and commercial maintenance and repair. Emphasis on safety, materials, and tool identification.

Course Type: Technical/Vocational Course

CBFM 1324 Interior Maintenance 3 Credit Hours (2 Lec, 3 Lab)

Building repair principles with emphasis on minor repair of walls, floors, and ceilings.

Course Type: Technical/Vocational Course

CBFM 1329 Maintenance and Coordination and Scheduling 3 Credit Hours (3 Lec)

An introduction to scheduling of repairs and preventive maintenance. Topics include ordering of supplies and equipment, work orders, and personnel scheduling.

CBFM 1334 Interior and Exterior Painting and Refinishing 3 Credit Hours (2 Lec, 3 Lab)

Interior and exterior painting and refinishing for commercial and residential applications.

Course Type: Technical/Vocational Course

CBFM 2280 Cooperative Education Building Property Maintenance and Manager 2 Credit Hours (1 Lec, 8 Lab)

Carreer related activities encountered in the student's area of specialization offered through an individualized agreement among the college, employer, and student. Under the supervision of the college and the employer, the student combines classroom learning with work experience. Includes a lecture component.

CBFM 2311 Building Maintenance II 3 Credit Hours (2 Lec, 3 Lab)

Continuation of Building Maintenance I with emphasis on the operational aspects of maintaining and repairing facilities.
