ECON 2302 Principles of Microeconomics Principles of Microeconomics 3 Credit Hours (3 Lec)

Analysis of the behavior of individual economic agents, including consumer behavior and demand, producer behavior and supply, price and output decisions by firms under various market structures, factor markets, market failures, and international trade. Prerequisite: ECON 2301.
