

COST OF ATTENDANCE

Every college or university estimates how much it will cost to attend for an academic year. This estimate, called the **Cost of Attendance (COA)**, helps students plan for their education expenses.

The COA includes two types of costs:

- **Direct Costs:** These are expenses paid directly to the school, like tuition and fees.
- **Indirect Costs:** These are additional expenses you may have, such as transportation, books, and personal needs, but you don't pay them directly to the college.

Your COA depends on whether you're a full-time or part-time student and your residency status (in-district, out-of-district, or out-of-state).
